Free bushwalks in Ellenbrook for residents

Come and explore your own backyard ...

A series of free community bushwalks have been planned for Ellenbrook, providing local residents the opportunity to explore the amazing myriad of flora and fauna surrounding the local area.

Sponsored by LWP Property Group, the walks will be hosted by Johnny 'the Frog Doctor' Prefumo and horticulturalist Sue Dempster from Everlasting Concepts.

The first of the free bushwalks will take place on Saturday 6th June to link in with World Environment Day on the 5th June. The walk will begin at 8am, meeting at the Malvern Springs Village Centre and will conclude at approximately 10am.

A second walk is planned for later in the year on Friday 4th September.

Justine Mountford, Project Manager, said the walks were a fantastic opportunity for local residents to learn more about their bush surroundings.

"The areas around Ellenbrook are abundant with local flora and fauna and these walks will give people the opportunity to see local fauna in different habitats, whilst being guided by experts in the field," Justine said.

"Johnny and Sue were involved in designing the landscape for Ellenbrook, and most recently in the village of Malvern Springs, and therefore both have an intimate knowledge of the area," Justine added.

Sue Dempster, Horticulturalist from Everlasting Concepts, helped plan each of the walks.

"The walk on the 6th of June will take people through both a melaleuca wetland as well as dry woodland within Malvern Springs. It is an opportunity to see several bird varieties in these varying habitats and will be a great morning out for all ages," Sue said.

"The second walk, in September, will be an evening walk and will focus on the theme of frogs, with our expert 'Johnny the Frog Doctor' providing delightful insights into these amazing creatures."

Malvern Springs, Ellenbrook's latest village, has been carefully designed to ensure bushland and wetland areas have been retained and the walks provide an opportunity for local residents to learn more about their local ecological environment.
